NOTE: In March 1st was performed the abolition of the choir-diaconie in the Brethren's house in Nazareth according to the resolution in the Unity's Elder-Conference in February 13th 1811. The cattle and agriculture of it, the stock and implements as well as the Activorum (receipts) and Passivorum (expenditures) of the Choir-Diaconie were in the mean time taken over by the warden of the congregation. The following changes resulted by this: 1) The former Warden of the single brethren, Br. Jacob Rauschenberger laid down his office on the same day. 2) Brother Friedr. Schmidt accepted the boarding of the brethren, who are living in the Brethren's house on their own account. The E. C. promised him, that he, as it had been in the choir-diaconie, should have in the future free board from the diaconie of the congregation. Further he should be exempted from all taxes for the congregation and for the choir. For the use of his present kitchen, for the tools and the garden as well as for the cellar no rent shall be charged. -----
