2.2 Administrative / Biographical History

Beginning 1728 monthly prayer days or *Gemeintage* were held in Herrnhut where letters and reports received during the previous month were shared with the congregation. In 1736 Moravians began writing reports of what took place at the prayer days, including extracts from the letters and reports that were read. These reports were then sent to other Moravian congregations.

The collection also contains several reports of children prayer days.

Spangenberg numbered the pages starting the Gemeintag of 15 July 1745. As he included various items that were not all Prayer Day Reports in his numbering, there are gaps in the numbering now that these items have been relocated to their appropriate collections.

2.3 Archival History

First organized by Matthäus Hehl in 1757. Vernon Nelson created a box inventory, probably at the time he compiled the overview of the Congregational Accounts. In 2020 the collection was processed by Paul Peucker. Until 2020 the collection was kept in the original wrappers from 1757. These have been preserved with the collection. Items found with the collection that were not Prayer Day Reports have been placed with other collections such as Reports from the Unity, Greenland Missions, and the Zinzendorf Papers.
