

COLLECTION DEVELOPMENT POLICY 3/2024

Mission

The Moravian Archives collects and preserves records and historical materials of Moravians in North America and makes them available to the public. It is the official repository of the records of the Moravian Church in America, Northern Province. The Archives fulfills its mission through archival processing, research services, education, publications, and public programming.

Types of holdings

The Moravian Archives collects archival collections, personal papers, manuscripts, books, paintings, architectural drawings, maps, photographs, selected objects, drawings, printed images, electronic data records.

Possible restrictions

If the item or the work is in such a condition that the Moravian Archives will not be able to appropriately care for it, it may not be accepted. If a donor requires that an item or work be permanently displayed, it may not be accepted.

Framed items may be taken out of their frames.
